## RULES FOR USAGE OF KALANIANAOLE HWY HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE (HOV) CONTRA-FLOW LANE

- 1. The HOV placard is valid for one calendar year (January 1 December 31). All permits approved for the calendar year expires on December 31.
- 2. The applicant shall apply for a new HOV placard at the end of every calendar year. Please allow two (2) weeks from when the Department of Transportation receives application to mail out new HOV placard.
- 3. The HOV placard must be visible in the right corner of the windshield.
- 4. Driver / permittee of a vehicle displaying HOV placard must reside on the east-bound, oceanside of Kalanianaole Highway between West Halemaumau Street and Ainakoa Avenue, and have no traffic signalized access onto Kalanianaole Highway.
- 5. The HOV placard is not transferable. HOV placard shall match vehicle license plate. Any change in vehicle will require driver / permittee to submit a new application for that vehicle.
- 6. If questioned by a police officer, the driver / permittee shall surrender the HOV placard to the officer for verification of qualification.
- 7. The driver / permittee shall forfeit the HOV placard to the attending police officer if he / she fails to abide by the rules / instructions.
- 8. Driver must comply with all applicable traffic rules and regulations of the Traffic Codes.
- 9. Driver must obey all traffic control devices.
- 10. Driver shall stay within the coned lane.
- 11. Once in the contra-flow lane, driver must stay in the lane until the exit at Ainakoa Avenue. Exiting the contra-flow lane at any other location is not allowed.
